



# BEARS MILE – SMALL BEAR 500

## RULES



- ★ The traveler must cover a distance of at least 500 miles (= 800 km) on a motorcycle of any modification.

- ★ The time required to hold

- ★ The traveler must submit an application at least 7 days before the start of his/her journey and report the proposed route and start date to [bears-mile@moto-bears.de](mailto:bears-mile@moto-bears.de) (e.g. Google Maps screenshot).
- ★ On the way, the traveller must keep the fuel receipts on which the speedometer readings are noted (photo) and the completed stages of the route are confirmed.
- ★ The fuel receipts confirm the time and place of the start, the intermediate refuelling along the route and the destination of the route taken. At the end of the trip, the traveler must provide the "Bears Mile" organizing committee with the fuel receipts by e-mail to: [bears-mile@moto-bears.de](mailto:bears-mile@moto-bears.de) (photo/scan) to confirm the mileage and compliance with the time frame. The receipts must be numbered in the order "from start to finish".
- ★ All routes that comply with the rules (500 miles/800 km in max. 24 hours) will be nominated.
- ★ One round of this competition is considered per year. Any number of attempts can be made. However, every new attempt should be registered, see above.
- ★ After successful completion of the competition, as well as confirmation and recognition by the organizer, the participant will be placed in the overall table.
- ★ After successful participation in the competition, each participant can purchase various commemorative utensils (patches, certificates, pins, etc.).
